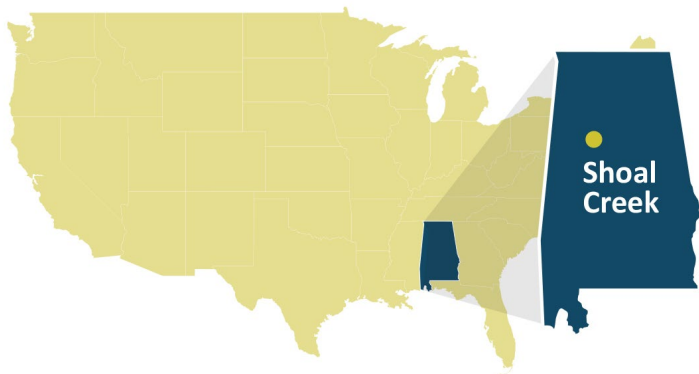

The Shoal Creek Mine was developed in 1994 and acquired by Peabody in 2018.



A longwall system is used to mine high quality hard coking coal located in the Blue Creek and Mary Lee coal seams.



The mine is located on the Black Warrior River with barge transportation leading to the Port of Mobile in the Gulf of Mexico, offering access to seaborne customers.
