

Operational Responses to Noise and Air Quality Data

Wambo Coal is committed to implementing noise and dust management measures to minimise off site impacts. Monitoring of the real time weather, air quality and noise monitoring network by key operational personnel, and alarm activation, enables operational responses to be implemented when required. Operational changes are guided by the Trigger, Action, Response Plans (TARP's) outlined in the relevant management plans.

The information in the table below summarises key operational responses made to elevated noise and dust levels and adverse weather conditions.
