LICENCE 529 - ANNIVERSARY NOTICE

I refer to Environment Protection Licence No. 529, issued to WAMBO COAL PTY LIMITED by the Environment Protection Authority (EPA), under the Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997 (the POEO Act).

This letter is to remind you of the annual licensing obligations, in particular the requirement to submit an Annual Return and annual licence fees.

Annual Return

Condition R1.5 of your licence requires that you complete and submit an Annual Return within 60 days of the end of each reporting period.

If you do not submit the Annual Return by the due date you may receive a fine of up to \$3000.

Licence Fees

Once your Annual Return is received by the EPA, the information provided will inform the EPA's determination of your environmental management category which the EPA will use to calculate the annual licence administrative fee. Once the EPA has determined your annual fee a Tax Invoice/Statement will be sent to you.

If the licensed activities are subject to Load-Based Licensing (LBL), payment of a load-based fee may also be required. The EPA will calculate the load based fee using the data you provide in the Annual Return. If the payment of a load based fee is required a separate Tax Invoice/Statement will be sent to you.

The licence fees will need to be paid to the EPA by 30-Apr-2017.

Failure to record 24hr averages of PM10 data due to hardware failures and local power outages.

EPL Monitoring Point 13 had five instances throughout the year where daily 24hr averages were incomplete. Three of these occasions were due to a faulty air conditioner unit within the monitoring hardware. The final two occasions were due to local power outages due to storms or scheduled maintenance.

EPL Monitoring Point 15 had one instance throughout the year where daily 24hr averages were incomplete. This was due to localised power outages as a result of a storm within the area.

At some unascertained time between 5th and 10th January 2016, the Montrose Sediment Dam wall failed during a major flooding event. This was considered to be a notifiable incident and was reported to the EPA on 11th January 2016. Investigations were subsequently undertaken by the EPA into the causes of the incident and Wambo cooperated fully with those investigations. Enforcement proceedings in relation to this incident have been commenced in the NSW Land and Environment Court. The outcome of these proceedings are still pending

OFFICIAL CAUTION

On 8 January 2016 the Environment Protection Authority ("EPA") received an email from Wambo Coal Pty Limited ("the Licensee") notifying the EPA of a technical failure of the continuous inline flow monitor required under condition M7.1 of Environment Protection Licence 529 ("the Licence"), during a discharge event under the Hunter River Salinity Trading Scheme ("HRSTS") on 7 January 2016.

The EPA required information from the Licensee in relation to the discharge event and the circumstances of the technical failure. The Licensee provided this information to the EPA on 12 February 2016.

The EPA notes there have been a number of issues identified in relation to discharge events under the HRSTS at this premises, including:

- On 23 April 2015 a probe failure event at Point 4 resulted in the Licensee implementing an alternative volumetric discharge calculation during the discharge event;
- The Annual Return for the 2013/2014 reporting period identified a non-compliance with Condition M2.3
 of the Licence relating to the failure to continuously monitor pH at Point 4 as required;
- The 2013/2014 HRSTS reporting period identified that Point 4 was 'on-line' for only 1% of the reporting period; and
- The 2008/2009 HRSTS reporting period identified Point 4 was not 'on-line' at any time during the 2008/09 reporting period.

It is an offence under Section 64 of the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997* ("the Act") for a person to contravene any condition of a licence. This offence carries a maximum penalty of \$1,000,000 for a corporation.

The EPA may prosecute a corporation for committing this offence. Alternatively, EPA may issue a corporation that commits this offence with a penalty notice, which carries a fine of \$15,000.

The EPA has reasonable grounds to believe that WAMBO COAL PTY LIMITED committed an offence under section 64 of the Act f(ailing to comply with Condition M7.1 of the Licence) by failing to undertake continuous inline monitoring of the discharge from Point 4 on 7 January 2016 ("the alleged offence"). Further, the EPA believes that there is sufficient evidence to prove the alleged offence.

In these circumstances, and having regard to the *Attorney General's Caution Guidelines under the Fines Act 1996*, the EPA considers it appropriate to issue WAMBO COAL PTY LIMITED with this Official Caution for the alleged offence.

Please note that EPA will retain a copy of this Official Caution on file. If WAMBO COAL PTY LIMITED commits an offence in future, EPA may take into account this Official Caution in determining the most appropriate enforcement action. Such action may involve the issue of a penalty notice or the commencement of a prosecution.

The issuing of this Official Caution does not prevent EPA from taking alternative enforcement action for the alleged offence, if it becomes apparent that an alternative response is more appropriate.
