



North Goonyella Mine – Bulletin
October 25, 2018

- Exclusion zones continue to be observed on site with underground access prohibited and limited access to surface areas of the mine.
- Activities on site continue to be interrupted by sporadic storm events and there is a renewed focus on controlling heat exposure for above ground response team employees working in daytime temperatures up to 38 degrees celsius.
- The first of five permanent seals was successfully installed this week to separate the mined-out area of the completed longwall panel from the rest of the mine. Work to install a second permanent seal is well advanced and most holes have been drilled to install the remaining three permanent seals.
- There is minimal, visible smoke or steam coming from mine openings.
- The mobile GAG unit remains connected but is not being used due to gradual improvements in the stability of the underground atmosphere.
- Air quality and surface vibration monitoring continues with no concerns.
