

## North Goonyella Mine – Bulletin December 19, 2018

- The onsite team continues to work from above ground to monitor gas levels and conditions underground using remote-control cameras, monitors and other equipment.
- Peabody will use the coming weeks to continue to monitor the mine, pump water and drill holes for additional temporary ventilation control devices in preparation for planned re-ventilation.
- Underground access remains prohibited at the site and exclusion zones apply to surface areas of the mine.
- Mine management continues to observe strict environmental standards and PPE protocol to ensure worker safety.
- CO levels across the mine remain slightly elevated.
- As previously reported, temporary ventilation control devices have been installed across the 53-54 cut-through area. Drilling has commenced to install another row of devices across the 19-20 cut-through area in preparation for planned reventilation.
- The company intends to resume periodic updates in January 2019.
